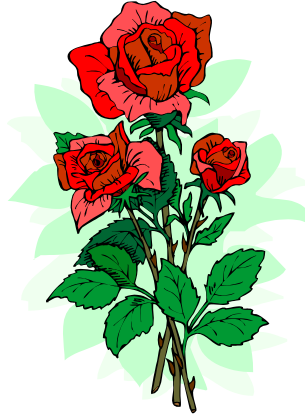

<b>A2</b>	Make a garden in a biscuit tin Max. size 30 x 40cms (12 x 16 ins )	8 – 12 years
<b>Class B1</b>	Photograph about the Jubilee Max. photo size A5: 21 x 15 cms (8 x 6 ins)	up to 12 years
<b>Class C1</b>	Hand made birthday card Max. size A5: 21 x 15 cms (8 x 6 ins)	up to 12 years
<b>Class D1</b>	4 cup cakes ( homemade or bought) to be hand decorated by you	4 – 7 years
<b>D2</b>	4 cup cakes (homemade or bought) to be hand decorated by you	8 – 12 years
<b>Class E1</b>	Painting about the Olympics Max. size A4: 30 x 21 cms (12 x 8 ins)	4 - 7 years
<b>E2</b>	Painting about the Olympics Max. size A4: 30 x 21 cms (12 x 8 ins) (Water colours or acrylic)	8 - 12 years

## **Adult section** (13 years and upwards)

### **FLOWER SECTION:**

**Class F1** One single rose from your garden in a vase

**F2** 3 roses from your garden in a vase

**F3** Vase of mixed flowers from your garden

### **DOMESTIC PRODUCE:**

**Class G1** Victoria Sponge (jam filled but **no** decoration, not even icing sugar)

Recipe: 2 eggs, plus equal weights of other ingredients)

**G2** 4 homemade fruit scones

**G3** Plate of 6 homemade biscuits (undecorated)

**G4** Jar of homemade jam or marmalade

**G5** Jar of homemade chutney or pickle

## **Adult section** (13 years and upwards) continued

### **CRAFTS:**

**Class H1** Photograph (mounted) of favourite holiday

Max. photo size A5: 21 x 15 cms (8 x 6 ins)

**Class I1** Hand made birthday card

Max. size A5: 21 x 15 cms (8 x 6 ins)

**Class J1** Hand made baby garment (0-12 months)

Knitted, crocheted or sewn

**J2** A woodcraft item

(wood modelling kits accepted)

**J3** An item made mainly from metal

(including jewellery)

## TIPS

1. All entries must be **anonymous**; you will be given a number to display with your exhibit(s).
2. Please ensure that your entries meet the criteria specified.
3. Victoria Sponge:
  - no icing/caster sugar or other decoration on top of sponge (judge is looking at colour and texture)
  - jam filling (no cream)
  - use recipe proportions as specified (judge will cut and taste sponge). Recipe based on 7 inch cake tin but size can vary.
4. Scones and biscuits:
  - ensure you present the correct number as stated
  - scones must be fruit and biscuits undecorated
  - judge is looking for uniform size and shape of your scones/biscuits, plus evenly cooked
5. Jam and chutney:
  - jars must be transparent, with waxed paper circle and cellophane cover secured with elastic band or ribbon
  - label on jar to show name of product and date made (**not** exhibitor's name)
6. Baby garment:  
garment, shawl or pram cover but must be **unused**

## RULES

1. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor and all exhibitors must be amateurs.
2. Entry forms can be collected from and must be returned to (plus appropriate fee) any of the following venues by **Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2012**:
  - a) Holy Trinity Church, Tarleton
  - b) Tarleton Library
  - c) Tarleton DIY Shop
  - d) Holy Trinity C of E Primary School
  - e) Mere Brow C of E Primary School
  - f) Tarleton Academy
  - g) T. Ascroft & Sons, Mere Brow
3. Junior classes are open to any child up to 12 years.
4. Exhibits will only be accepted on the morning of the Rose Queen Day from **9am -11am** at the **Village Show Marquee** on the school field, Holy Trinity Primary School, Church Road, Tarleton.
5. Judging takes place at 11.30am, and decisions of the judges are final.
6. No exhibits to be removed before 4pm, but all must be collected by 5pm.
7. All trophies are to be held for one year only.
8. All entries must be **anonymous** (i.e. no names showing, cards must be unsigned, photos must not disclose exhibitors identify).
9. The organisers accept no liability for loss or damage to items/exhibits.
